Multi-Unit Residential Premises

Regulated Price Plan (RPP):

Multi-Unit Residential customers who own a building that has multiple residences, but only one meter and who buy their electricity from Greater Sudbury Hydro Inc. (GSH) and don't have a contract with an electricity retailer may declare this information to qualify for the RPP tiered pricing rates for residential units. The Ontario Energy Board sets the commodity rates for the Regulated Price Plan.

Step One – Does your account qualify?

Your account qualifies if your property falls into one of the following categories:

- Your account relates to: a dwelling, a property as defined in the *Condominium Act, 1998*, a residential complex as defined in the *Residential Tenancies Act, 2006*, or a property that includes one or more housing units and that is owned or leased by a co-operative as defined in the *Co-operative Corporations Act*.

Step Two – Complete the form:

If your account qualifies, please fill in the information below. If you have more than one account that qualifies, list each qualifying account separately. Please attach a separate page should you require additional space. If there are units in your building or complex that are metered or billed separately from the account referenced, do not include them in the total number of units for this account.

You must advise GSH in writing if your account ceases to qualify or there is a change in the number of units within the property or complex. Failure to do so will lead to the requirement to reimburse to GSH any credit outside of the eligible time frame.

All information submitted in this process will be used by GSH in support of its obligations under the Electricity Act, 1998, the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998, applicable Ontario Energy Board Codes and Rules, associated policies, standards and procedures and GSH's license. GSH will use the information collected on this form for the purposes of confirming your eligibility for the RPP.
